## SHOW RULES

1. You may make up to a maximum of 3 entries in any class in this Schedule, so long as:
  - a. you meet the age requirements of Classes 66-80; and
  - b. you aren't a Judge for the Class you are entering.
2. Please use the entry form at the back of this Schedule. If you want extra copies, download them from the Show website (<http://www.thebucknellshow.co.uk>), photocopy the original or pick up an extra copy from Green's Garage. Use one form per competitor.
3. Get your completed form, with the entry fee, to Clare Cottage, Sitwell Close, Bucknell NO LATER than 5.00pm on 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2020.
4. Staging of exhibits starts at 9.00am on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2020 at the Daffodil Lane site and must be completed by 10.30am in time for judging.
5. **Collect your exhibitor's cards at the Show tent when you stage your entries. They will NOT be available from Clare Cottage.**
6. The name of the exhibitor must not be visible to the judge.
7. Except for floral art materials etc, all exhibits are to be grown, made, crafted or created by the exhibitor her/himself.
8. Entries in Classes 28-47 may not include a prize-winning item from any previous year.
9. The Bucknell Show Committee cannot be held responsible for any exhibit.
10. Exhibits should be removed as soon as possible after 5.00pm: NOT before then.
11. With the exception of Class 27, prizes will be awarded as follows:

Open Classes: 1<sup>st</sup> £1-50, 2<sup>nd</sup> £1-00, 3<sup>rd</sup> 50p; Young People: 1<sup>st</sup> £1-00, 2<sup>nd</sup> 50p, 3<sup>rd</sup> 20p.

## COOKERY CLASS 55 – PRESCRIBED RECIPE

### Honey Cake

#### Ingredients

2 tbsp runny honey	200g unsalted butter
80g dark brown soft sugar	2 large eggs
200g self-raising flour	1½ tsp mixed spice
100g icing sugar sifted	

#### Method

1. Put honey, butter and brown sugar into a saucepan; melt together over a low heat. When the sugar has dissolved, turn up the heat and leave to bubble for 1min. Take off heat and leave to cool for 15mins.
2. Preheat the oven to 160C° (140° fan) Gas mark 3. Line a 900g (2lb) loaf tin with parchment paper.
3. Add the beaten eggs into the cooled butter mixture in the saucepan.
4. Sift the flour and mixed spice into a large bowl and add the butter mixture, mix well, then pour into the prepared tin.
5. Bake for 40-50 mins or until a skewer inserted into the centre of the cake comes out clean.
6. Leave to cool for 5 mins in the tin, then take out and leave to cool completely on a wire rack.
7. To make the glaze. Put the pre-weighed icing sugar into a bowl and whisk in just enough water to make a runny consistency. Drizzle over the cooled cake; and leave to harden.
